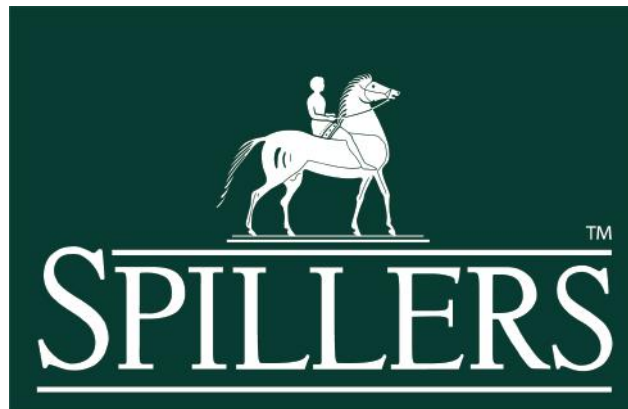

**CLASS 1:** Maximum Height First Round 70cms (Restricted to riders aged 14 years and under on 1 January 2022).

**CLASS 2:** Maximum Height First Round 80cms.

**CLASS 3:** Maximum Height First Round 90cms.

**AWARDS:** Rosettes to 10<sup>th</sup> place and sashes to the winning team in each Class.

**Points Accumulator** – Points awarded in each Class. 6 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place down to 1 point for 6<sup>th</sup> place. The Branch scoring the highest number of points across all three classes will be awarded a £500 Spillers Training Bursary

The competition will run under Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2022, Speed 325 m/min. except as modified below:

Each team member will jump Round One once. Best three scores to count. The top six teams will qualify for Round Two. In the event of equality of jumping faults placing for qualification will be decided taking the aggregate time for the three team members with the lowest jumping faults. Jumping faults will be carried forward to Round Two. Round Two will be jumped over a shortened course with teams jumping in reverse order (ie the team with most faults will jump first and the clear rounds last). In the event of equality of faults after the second round final places will be decided taking the aggregate time for the three team members with the lowest jumping faults in that round. Eliminated competitors will take the worst score for the round in which they were eliminated, plus 20 faults.

In the event of two teams from a Branch qualifying for the second round they will both receive rosettes. However, only the higher placed team will count towards the branches total points.

Points will then be awarded to the next highest placed team(s) in the first round.

In the event of equality of points the Bursary will be awarded to the Branch jumping the greater number of clear rounds in the second rounds. If these are the same the branch with the highest placed team in Class 3 will be awarded the bursary.

#### **Entries:**

- The Entry fee is £80 per team per class, which includes £6 team contribution towards paramedic costs. All costs include VAT at the prevailing rate.
- Entry fee includes entry for lorries/trailers plus two passes for each team member, ie one pass for the rider and one for an accompanying adult. Each team will also be issued with one additional pass for the Team Trainer/Manager or DC.  
Additional occupants will be charged at the gate price. Tickets can be purchased online in advance at [www.rockinghamcastlehorsetrials.com](http://www.rockinghamcastlehorsetrials.com).
- No accompanying vehicles are allowed in the Lorry/Trailer Park.
- Entries close Thursday 28 April 2022 or earlier if oversubscribed.
- Branches may enter a maximum of two teams per Class. Riders and horses/ponies do not need to be named on the Entry Form. Please indicate if the Branch would like to enter an additional team if time/space allows.
- Entries will be limited and taken on a first come first served basis. A waitlist will be in operation.
- Two copies of the names of riders and horses/ponies should be submitted on the Declaration Forms on the day of competition. **Please complete both Declaration Forms prior to arrival** ready to submit to the Pony Club Declaration Steward in the Pony Club marquee **at least one hour** before the team is due to jump.
- Declaration Forms be available to download on the Pony Club page of the Horse Trials website [www.rockinghamcastlehorsetrials.com](http://www.rockinghamcastlehorsetrials.com) nearer the time of the competition and must be signed by the District Commissioner or their appointed representative.
- Entry Form to be sent to: Susan Hutchinson, The Estate Office, Rockingham Castle, Market Harborough, Leicestershire, LE16 8TH. Entry fees can be paid by BACs with details lists on the entry form.
- Please mark the top left-hand corner of the envelope with 'Pony Club Entry'. Receipt of entry will be sent by email.
- Withdrawals by email to [horsetrials@rockinghamcastle.com](mailto:horsetrials@rockinghamcastle.com) **must be** made by Friday 6 May 2022 at 12.00hrs. All entries before this date will be issued with a full refund minus £8.00 admin fee. Withdrawals after 12.01hrs on 6 May 2022 are non-refundable.
- Start times and running order will be published on the Pony Club page of the Horse Trials website [www.rockinghamcastlehorsetrials.com](http://www.rockinghamcastlehorsetrials.com) from 18.00hrs on Tuesday 17 May 2022.

### ***Terms and Conditions:***

1. Teams to consist of 3 or 4 current Pony Club members aged 25 years and under except Class 1 only, age 14 and under. Only one rider over the age of 20 is permitted per team in Classes 2 and 3. Riders can only take part once in each class and in not more than two classes.  
All ages to be taken on 1 January 2022.
2. The following are not eligible to take part: Combination of horse/pony and rider who have competed at the Pony Club Intermediate Show Jumping Championships, or at the Open Area and/or Pony Club Show Jumping and Eventing Championships.
3. Horses/ponies can only take part once in each class and in not more than two classes.
4. No horse/pony under 5 years of age is eligible. Stallions can only be ridden by members if they have obtained written permission from their District Commissioner/Centre Proprietor and in the interests of safety, must wear identifying discs on their bridle.
5. Vaccinations must be up to date and in line with British Eventing rules (e.g. 6 monthly vaccinations). See Competitors page of website for full details. Passports should be made available if requested; we reserve the right to carry out spot checks of passports on the day.
6. Protests or objections must be made by the Team Manager/Trainer to the Secretary, not later than 30 minutes after the happening or 20 minutes after the scores have been published. Objections/protests must be accompanied by a £25 fee.
7. The Judge's decision is final. The Judge reserves the right to disqualify any rider at any stage of the competition for dangerous riding, inappropriate behaviour, misuse of whip or spurs, ill treatment of the horse or if in their opinion the horse is lame, sick or exhausted.
8. The Organisers of the Rockingham International Horse Trials reserve the right to make any changes and/or amendments to the competition and/or rules.
9. Paramedics and Vet will be in attendance.

### ***Other Notices***

#### *Estate Rules:*

- Rockingham Castle Estate is a heritage site, please respect this.
- All dogs must be kept on leads and under control. Please bag and bin dog waste.
- No horses/ponies may be left outside lorries/trailers unattended.
- No hay nets may be tied to the outside lorries/trailers.
- All droppings must be removed from the lorry park before departure.
- When mounted, all competitors must use the designated Horse Walks; failure to do so may result in elimination.
- Please take your rubbish home.

*Access* – please allow plenty of time to arrive as a one way system to the site will be in operation.

No accompanying cars allowed in Lorry Park, please follow signs for the Visitor Car Park.
