## TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. Classes are Unaffiliated and are open to everyone, BE members and non-members alike.
2. Riders must be 10 years of age or older on the date of the competition to compete. Children under the age of 10 may compete but must seek the Organiser's permission in advance.
3. Horses/Ponies must be 4 years of age or older but any height may compete.
4. Vaccinations must be up to date and in line with British Eventing & FEI rules. As per BE rule 10.2 – 10.3 an initial course of two primary vaccinations, not less than 21 days and not more than 92 days apart, are required before being eligible to compete. A first booster injection must be given within seven months after the date of administration of the second primary dose with at least annual boosters given subsequently. The most recent booster injection must have been given within the six calendar months and 21 days prior to the horse/pony arriving at the competition. A horse/pony may not compete if it has been given an injection on any of the 7 days before the event.
5. Passports should be made available if requested; we reserve the right to carry out spot checks of passports on the day.
6. British Eventing points will not apply.
7. Riders must wear hard hats at all times when mounted and compete, wearing full cross-country kit including back protectors. Hats and back protectors must comply with 2023 BE rules.
8. Horse or Rider substitutions will be accepted at a cost of £12 but horse **and** rider substitutions will NOT be accepted. Substitutions to be emailed ONLY to [tissiereason@gmail.com](mailto:tissiereason@gmail.com) by 12.00hrs on 16 May 2022.
9. Riders will jump one continual round, the first phase will start with show jumps and immediately be followed by phase two made up of cross country fences and a final fence being a show jump Joker fence. The xc phase will be based on an optimum time of 375m/min.

Faults will be awarded as follows:

Refusal at SJ	4 Faults
3 Refusals at same SJ	Elimination
4 Refusals at total SJ's	Elimination
Knockdown of SJ	4 Faults
Refusal at XC	20 Faults
2nd Refusal at same XC	40 Faults
3rd Refusal at same XC	Elimination
4 Refusals at total XC	Elimination
1st Rider Fall (Any Phase)	20 Faults (Time Stops – you may continue)
2nd Rider Fall (Any Phase)	Elimination
Horse Fall (Any Phase)	Elimination
Knock down of SJ Joker	8 Faults
Refusal at SJ Joker	20 Faults

**The Winner** will be the rider with the lowest score, which has been accumulated over the two phases and SJ Joker and closest to the optimum xc time.

10. No competitor is permitted to ride more than two horses per class.
11. **The Judge's Decision is final.** Any appeals must be made to the secretary within 15 minutes of the class finishing or within half an hour of the happening and must be accompanied by a £25 deposit which is refundable if the appeal is granted. The Judge reserves the right to disqualify any rider at any stage of the competition for dangerous riding, inappropriate behaviour, misuse of whip or spurs or if, in the vets opinion the horse is unfit to compete.
12. The Organisers of the Rockingham International Horse Trials reserve the right to make any changes and/or amendments to the competition or rules. The Organiser also reserves the right to refuse entries.
13. Opening Date: **17 March 2023**
14. Closing Date: **28 April 2023** or earlier if oversubscribed.
15. Commentator Information must be completed on the Entry Form.

Show jumps and cross country fences to be a maximum of 70cms and final fence to be a SJ Joker of 75cms max

**Class 2: Arena Eventing (0.80m)**

Show jumps and cross country fences to be a maximum of 80cms and final fence to be a SJ Joker of 85cms max

**Class 3: Arena Eventing (0.90m)**

Show jumps and cross country fences to be a maximum of 90cms and final fence to be a SJ Joker of 95cms max
