

British Riding Club Competition Fairfax & Favor Rockingham International Horse Trials Sunday 21 May 2023

CLASS 1: 70cms

CLASS 2: 80cms

CLASS 3: 90cms

CLASS 4: 1m

AWARDS: Rosettes to 10th place in each class.
Team Rosettes to 6th Place and Sashes to the overall winning team.
Prizes to the top three teams: 1st Prize £130, 2nd Prize £70 & 3rd Prize £36.

This is a team competition for British Riding Club Members only.

The competition will run under British Riding Club Show Jumping Rules 2023.

Teams can consist of three or four members with up to two junior members per team. One rider per class.

Each class will be single phase over a course of show jumps. The second section of the course will be timed and will be 5cms higher than the class height (i.e.: 75cm, 85cm, 95cm and 105cm max.) except the Joker fence, which will be 10cm above the class height (i.e.: 80cm, 90cm, 1m & 1.10m).

The final fence will be a choice between a Joker fence and a final show jumping fence. The regular final fence will incur standard show jumping penalties. However, if the Joker is jumped clear, 5 seconds will be deducted from the rider's time score, but the Joker will incur increased penalties. See table below:

The winning team will be the team with the lowest accumulated points scored over the team's best three rounds. In each class points will be allocated to each competitor according to their placing (i.e., $1^{st} = 1$ point, $10^{th} = 10$ points, $20^{th} = 20$ points etc.) In the event of equality of points the team with the lowest team time score over the best three rounds will win. In the event of a team time score tie, the lowest time score for the 1m class will be taken. If the drop score is the 1m round, the 90cm rider's time score will be used.

Entries:

- The Entry fee is £92 per team which includes £6 team contribution towards paramedic costs. All costs include VAT at the prevailing rate.
- Bib Numbers will be available to download from <u>www.ridingclubresults.co.uk</u> from 18.00hrs on 16 May 2023. Please print three numbers for each competitor, two for the bib and one to be displayed in the trailer/lorry. Trailer/lorry's not displaying a number will be charged at the gate price. Additional guests' tickets can be purchased online in advance from <u>www.rockinghamcastlehorsetrials.com</u>.
- No accompanying vehicles are allowed in the Lorry/Trailer Park.
- Six monthly equine vaccinations are required to enter the event online with FEI Regulations. The most recent equine influenza vaccination needs to be on or after 1st November 2022 (6 months and 21 days). You cannot compete any horse vaccinated on or after Sunday 14th May 2023 (seven days). Please send a copy of the front page and vaccination page of passport by the closing date to rockinghamrcpassports@gmail.com
- Entries close Thursday 27 April 2023 at 12.00hrs or earlier if oversubscribed.
- Entries will be limited and will be on a first come first served basis. A waitlist will be in operation.
- Riding Clubs may enter a maximum of two teams. Riding Clubs can indicate on the Entry Form if they would like to enter more teams, if space/time permits.
- Riders and horses/ponies need to be named on the Entry Form.
- Riders and horses/ponies can be substituted on the Declaration Forms, but Riders and Horses/Ponies must comply with BRC Rules.
- Declaration forms can be submitted by email in advance to <u>rockinghamrcpassports@gmail.com</u>. Declaration forms should be submitted on Friday 19 May before 20.00hrs. After this time two copies of the Declaration Form **should be** submitted on the day of competition to the Declaration Steward in the Riding Club Secretaries tent **at least one hour** before the team is due to jump. **Please have the Declaration Forms completed before you arrive.**
- Declaration Forms will be available to download on the Riding Club page of the Horse Trials website <u>www.rockinghamcastlehorsetrials.com</u> nearer the time of the competition and must be signed by the Team Manager or appointed representative.
- Entry Form & payment to be sent to: The Estate Office, Rockingham Castle, Market Harborough, Leicestershire, LE16 8TH or by email to <u>horsetrials@rockinghamcastle.com</u>. Please mark the top left-hand corner of envelope with 'Riding Club Entry'. Receipt of entry will be sent by email.
 Payment can be by Cheque or BACS. Cheques to be made out to Rockingham Castle Estates.
 BACS details can be found on the Entry Form.
- Withdrawals by email to <u>horsetrials@rockinghamcastle.com</u> **must be** made by Friday 5 May 2023 at 12.00hrs. All entries before this date will be issued with a full refund minus £8.00 admin fee. Withdrawals after 12.01hrs on 5 May 2023 are non-refundable.
- Class Start Times, Running Order & printable bib numbers will be published on <u>www.ridingclubresults.co.uk</u> from 18.00hrs on Tuesday 16 May 2023.
- Competitor scores will be shown online at <u>www.ridingclubresults.co.uk</u> but the team results will be shown manually, in the Riding Club Secretary's tent.

Terms and Conditions:

- 1. Teams to consist of 3 or 4 current Riding Club members with a maximum of two junior members per team. Junior members must be clearly shown on the Entry Form.
- 2. Riding Club Membership Numbers and all horses BS or BE points must be completed on the Entry & Declaration Forms
- 3. In the team, Rider one to jump Class 1 (70cms), Rider two to jump Class 2 (80cms), Rider three to jump Class 3 (90cms) and Rider four to jump Class 4 (1m). The highest riders score will be dropped for the team total.
- 4. If the team consists of three members only, they must be a competing in different height classes. All scores to count for team total.
- 5. A combination of Horse and Rider can only compete once. The rider can compete a second time in another team on a different horse. Horses may only compete once.
- 6. Classes to be drawn order but local clubs to go first.
- 7. Individual Rosettes will be awarded at the end of each class for classes 1, 2 & 3 in the Declaration Tent. Individual Rosettes for class 4 will be awarded at the end of the class on the Prize Giving Podium by the Main Secretary's tent. Team rosettes and prizes and overall winning team sashes will be awarded on the Prize Giving Podium following the class 4 prize giving. Please wear appropriate riding attire as per BRC rules.

- 8. Protests or objections must be made by the Team Manager to the Secretary, not later than 30 minutes after the happening or 15 minutes after the scores have been published. Objections/protests must be accompanied by a £25 fee.
- 9. Riders cannot compete below a height that they are qualified to do see BRC eligibility rules page 97 BRC 2023 Handbook.
 - Class 1 (70cms) See BRC 2023 Rule for Novice SJ Competitions
 - Class 2 (80cms) See BRC 2023 Rule for Novice SJ Competitions
 - Class 3 (90cms) See BRC 2023 Rule for Intermediate SJ Competitions
 - Class 4 (1m) See BRC 2023 Rule for Intermediate SJ Competitions
- 10. All horses and ponies must be over four years of age.
- 11. Vaccinations must be up to date and in line with British Eventing & FEI rules. As per BE rule 10.2 10.3 an initial course of two primary vaccinations, not less than 21 days and not more than 92 days apart, are required before being eligible to compete.

A first booster injection must be given within seven months after the date of administration of the second primary dose with at least annual boosters given subsequently. The most recent booster injection must have been given within the six calendar months and 21 days prior to the horse/pony arriving at the competition. A horse/pony may not compete if it has been given an injection on any of the 7 days before the event.

- 12. Passports should be made available if requested; we reserve the right to carry out spot checks of passports on the day.
- 13. The Judge's decision is final. The Judge reserves the right to disqualify any rider at any stage of the competition for dangerous riding, inappropriate behaviour, misuse of whip or spurs, ill treatment of the horse or if in their opinion the horse is lame, sick or exhausted.
- 14. The Organisers of the Fairfax & Favor Rockingham International Horse Trials reserve the right to make any changes and/or amendments to the competition and/or rules.
- 15. Paramedics and a Vet will be in attendance.
- 16. All hats must be tagged with the current BE, BRC or Pony Club Aqua tag. There will be a person eligible to hat tag in the Declaration Tent.
- 17. Please see page 37 of the BRC 2023 rule book G23.1.1: Whips

Other Notices
